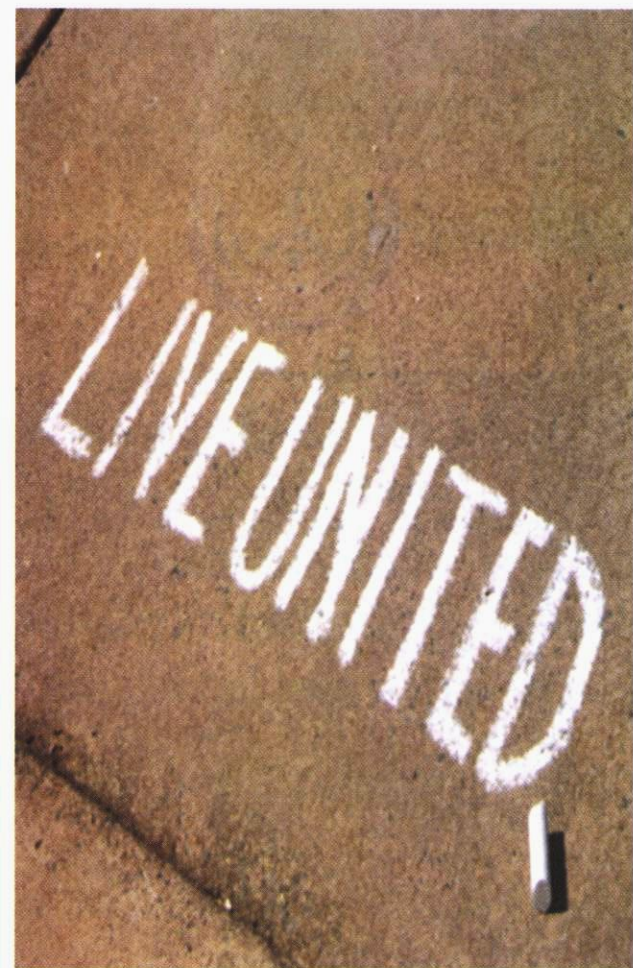
Crisis Needs: Food, Clothing and Shelter
